WELCOME TO THE POOL LAB

Create a pool for anything you can think of!

WE OFFER 3 POOL TYPES:

Type 1- Single Event Style

- One time/ one day event
- Customizable scoring
- One time results
- Examples: Baby Pools, The Oscars, Office Party Predictions

Type 2 - Pick'em Style

- Scheduled matchup with no rounds
- Can be over multiple days
- Each correct pick earns points
- Examples: Boxing Card, Regular Season Pick'em, Tennis Tournament

Type 3 - Tournament Style


- Each round represents a different stage of a tournament e.g round robin, semi-finals, finals
- Rounds can be spread across multiple days
- Each correct pick earns points.
- Examples: Minor League Tournament, Pickleball League, Playoffs.


SINGLE EVENT POOL (TYPE 1)

- One time results








HOW TO SET UP A SINGLE EVENT POOL



- 1. Go to The Pool Lab page on our site and click "Create Pool".
- 2. Select 'TYPE 1' as your pool type.
- 3. Fill in all the details here and add a photo or logo.
- 4. Click the red '+ Round' to create a round of your pool. This will be the question the poolies will be picking the answer to.
- 5. Click and enter the round title and assign how many points will be awarded for this round.
- 6. Click to edit each box pick.






- 7. When you click to edit the picks you will be brought here.
- 8. Enter the answer (Pick Title) and you can edit the colour of the picks to make your pool more fun!
- 9. Hit Save.
- 10. You will be re-directed to Step 3 where you can create the next round.
- 11. Once you hit save at the bottom of the page, you can go back into each pick and add an image. You must click save first.





- 7. Click the blue pencil icon to start adding the team details.






- 8. Edit the game time.





SINGLE EVENT
